



MEDICATION-ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)

Youth Ages 14-17 Years Old

MAT is the use of FDA-approved medications, in combination with counseling and behavioral therapies, to provide a “whole patient” approach to treatment of substance use disorders.

Medications Commonly Used for Opioid Use Disorder



Many people benefit from treatment with medication, counseling, and behavioral therapy to give them the best shot at recovery. Often these medications can help people stop using opioids and subdue the withdrawal pains.

How to Access MAT Services

Eligibility is based on full scope Medi-Cal and/or the lack of insurance that covers Substance Use treatment services and for individuals living in Sacramento County experiencing substance use problems.
